



10 COMMANDMENTS OF SHOOTING SAFETY

1. **TREAT EVERY GUN AS IF IT WERE LOADED.**
2. **WATCH THAT MUZZLE!** Carry your gun safely, never pull a gun toward you by the muzzle.
3. **NEVER POINT A GUN AT ANYTHING YOU DO NOT WANT TO SHOOT.** Avoid all horseplay.
4. **ALWAYS BE SURE OF YOUR TARGET BEFORE YOU SHOOT,** be sure backstop is adequate. Know the maximum range of your gun.
5. **UNLOAD GUNS WHEN NOT IN USE.** Guns should be carried in cases to shooting area.
6. **NEVER CROSS A FENCE OR JUMP A DITCH WITH WITH A LOADED GUN.**
7. **BE SURE BARREL IS CLEAR OF OBSTRUCTIONS,** and that you have the right ammunition for the gun you are using.
8. **NEVER SHOOT A BULLET AT WATER OR A FLAT, HARD SURFACE.** You can't control the path of a ricochet.
9. **STORE GUNS AND AMMUNITION SEPARATELY** and locked up if possible, out of the reach of children.
10. **AVOID ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** before or during shooting.
