Things to Remember:

- All projects are for youth, ages 9-18. You do not have to be a current 4-H member to register.
- **Payment is due at time of registration.** Make checks out to Breckinridge County 4-H Council. Forms can be mailed to or dropped off at the Breckinridge County Extension Office, 1377 S Hwy 261 Hardinsburg, KY 40143
- Participant’s spots will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis upon receipt of form and payment.
- **Lunch is included in the class fee for day camps. There is no meal provided for workshops.** Most materials will be covered, but participants may be asked to bring additional items (e.g. photos for the Scrapbooking & Poster Day Camp).
- **Deadline to register is May 17th. No late registrations will be accepted** –materials have to be purchased and lunches have to be ordered.
- All day camps will be held at the Breckinridge County Extension Office in the location specified above.
- Projects that are completed by the end of the day and are eligible for entrance in the 4-H Department of the Breckinridge County Fair can be left at our office – we will enter them into the fair for your 4-Her!
